A personal favorite, explore the freedom of expressing yourself making creative papers for collage, scrapbooking or as decorative papers for the book arts. Fun decorative techniques, few limitations, follow up with more at home. (Just a little messy, bring a smock, it's akin to fingerpainting!) No experience required, may be repeated

These papers are wonderful for binding books, making boxes, backgrounds for stamping or collages, calligraphy projects and beautiful journal pages!

There will be lots of tools on hand for making various patterns and images in the paste! Handouts for the class will contain recipes and alternative approaches.

Students should bring:

Smock and studio use rag or hand towel

Paper recommendations

- Several pieces Arches Text Wove Paper or Mohawk Superfine to be cut down (about 9" x 12")
- One sheet of Stonehenge Black or Arches Black to be cut down (about 9" x 12")
OR Several sheets of black cardstock (not construction paper)
- 3-4 Sponge Brushes about 1 ½" wide
- 2 large water containers (about the size of a 1 lb. Cottage cheese container)
- 6 yogurt or similar sized small containers
- Natural Sea Sponge
