

Contemporary Encaustics SUPPLY LIST Jenny Learner

Required

- **6-8 wood or fiber substrates (6x6, 8x10, 10x10, 9x12 or similar sizes, not larger than 12x12) – or any non-warping, rigid, absorbent material – lumber scraps OK**
- **Brushes, small and medium bristle, sable and or Hake. Can be cheap bristle ones from your paint or hardware store.**
- **Tape, scissors, wax paper, metal ruler and sketch pad.**
- **Wear paint cloths or bring apron.**

Optional

- Bring an old painting or drawing to rework under 12" x 12" any medium.
- 6"square masonite panels primed from Dick Blick great for working on
- small mirrors - dollar store
- Dried pressed flowers or leaves from your favorite plant, dry or live.
- Half a dozen small cans (cat food size).
- You may want to bring your own mark making tools: ceramic tools, linoleum cutters, single edge razor blades, dental, culinary, etc.
- a few favorite photographs which have been duplicated on a black/white and/or color copier – some might be enlarged to completely cover a panel you bring
- various collage materials including special papers, string, dried natural materials and objects
