Materials fee to cover Assortment of recycled papers Linters and alternative fibers as paper base

Students to supply:

2 packages of handi wipes, or Old towels or wool blankets that can be cut down to size

Note book/pen/pencil

Assorted empty plastic containers 3 or 4 (margarine, larger yogurt, ice cream)

Sponge, like those used for cleaning - size comfortable for your hand

Masking tape and permanent marker (sharpie)

Old cookie sheet/bar pan or similar base board for transporting paper

Rubber or plastic apron is useful

Rubber dishwashing gloves to fit your hands

Safety Glasses/Goggles

Optional or as desired for drying at home: 10-15 blotters and cardboard

Papers to recycle – best to come to class and we will discuss resources for your recycling efforts – the better the paper scraps the better the paper pulp you will make. High % cotton is best & the color of the paper scraps will determine color of the paper pulp you create
