

Screen Printing Materials List

Instructor will provide:

Some previously dyed fabric pieces for each student
Some soda soaked Cotton for each student (1 ½ yds)
Dyes
Sodium Alginate Thickener
Discharge Paste
Soy Wax
Parrafin/Beeswax block
Small screens to use (2 per student)
Squeegees
Freezer Paper
Latex or vinyl gloves
Variety of textural objects

Materials Students should bring:

Elmer's Blue Gel Glue
2 yards of prewashed 100% white cotton fabric (preferably pfd* Kona cotton or muslin) or silk or rayon
**prepared for dyeing*
Scissors for paper
Textures (1/4" or less in thickness)-Could include corrugated cardboard pieces, rubber bands, sink mats, lace, ric-rac, texture rubbing plates, rug gripper, etc.
Screenprint screen (optional- available at Michael's, Dick Blick, etc.-12" x 18", 14"x 16", or your own preference- may want to wait to invest in after class)
Squeegee (optional, but size should be 2" smaller than inside of screen if you get one)
Apron or old shirt
Rags or paper towels
