

Supply List

Bookmaking Basic Supply List

- *Folding Bone (aka Bone Folder)*
- *Fettling Knife*
- *Needle*
- *Scissors*
- *Exacto knife and/or Utility Knife if you have one*
- *Self sealing mat for cutting on if you have one*
- *Metal straight edge or ruler, bring what you have*
- *Notebook/pen/pencil*
- *Sobo or Eileen's Tacky glue (small size), small container with tight fitting lid, (like a baby food container), & a glue stick*

Additional items to bring if you have them, I will have available for use

- curved sewing needle
- awl or Japanese Screw Punch

Paper of Choice for text block (signatures)

Six signatures - I used a Watercolor 9 x 12 Paper Pad cutting the paper in half, folding and nesting the papers. Six signatures, each with two folios.

(Closed Book Dimensions papers 4 1/2" x 6" = 6 sheets, cut sheets in half, 9 x 6, nest 2 sheets per signature = 4 1/2" x 6")

Book Covers - materials provided or B. Y. O.

There will be a selection of plain & decorative papers, book cloth or fabric to choose from for covering the book board covers. However, you may choose to bring other personal materials. Take into consideration, you will need enough material to cover the three pieces; front/back cover and spine piece, each individually. Also needed are end-sheets covering the inside of all three boards.

In my example, I needed materials to cover (2) 4 5/8" x 6 1/4" covers & (1) 3/4" x 6 1/4" spine (spine thickness is determined by the thickness or depth of the signatures, which in turn is determined by the weight of the papers...)
