An introduction to Thermo-imaging (thermo fax machine) screen making/printing using high contrast images. Materials fee cover one image. Additional screens/images may be purchased on individual basis. Some fabrics will be available for individual purchases, but you are encouraged to bring your own. Thermo Images & Fabric Screen Printing Supply List

High Contrast image (s) can be digital

2-3 yards of white cotton fabric

a small squeegee, more like a plastic scrapper – if you have one

1" foam brushes, 2-3

old rag towels, protective clothing (such an apron or old t-shirt) and gloves if you don't want the fabric paint to get on your hands.

Optional:

Favorite metallic or fabric paints you'd like to use for screening (although paints will also be provided for students as part of the supplies fee)

Prewashed cotton fat quarters if desired for image layering
